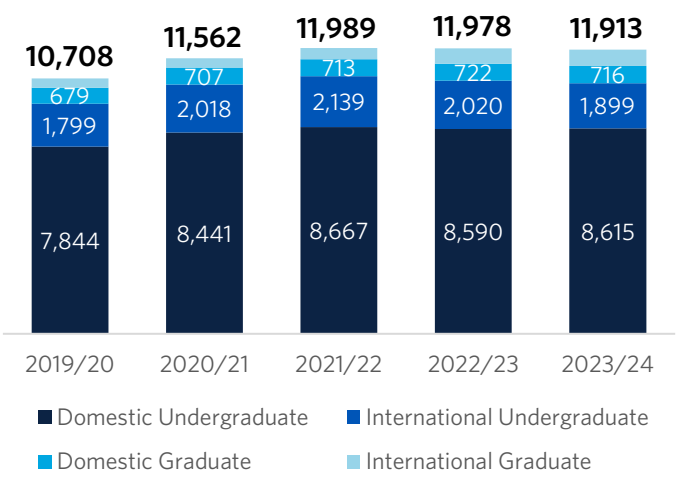


Campus Facts 2023/24

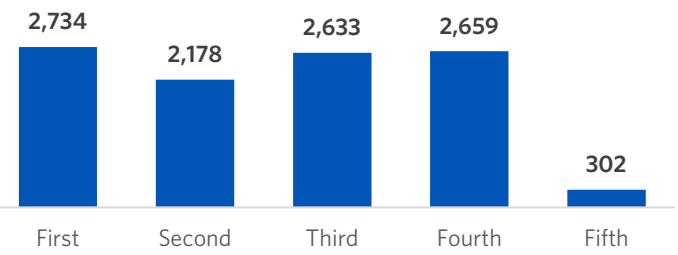
Student Enrolment

HEADCOUNT OVER TIME



Headcount totals are valid as of November 1. Total headcount excludes visiting international research students (VIRO), who, although attending UBC and assigned student numbers, are not enrolled in "for-credit" courses. There were 49 students in this category in 2023/24.

OVERALL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT HEADCOUNT BY PROGRAM YEAR LEVEL



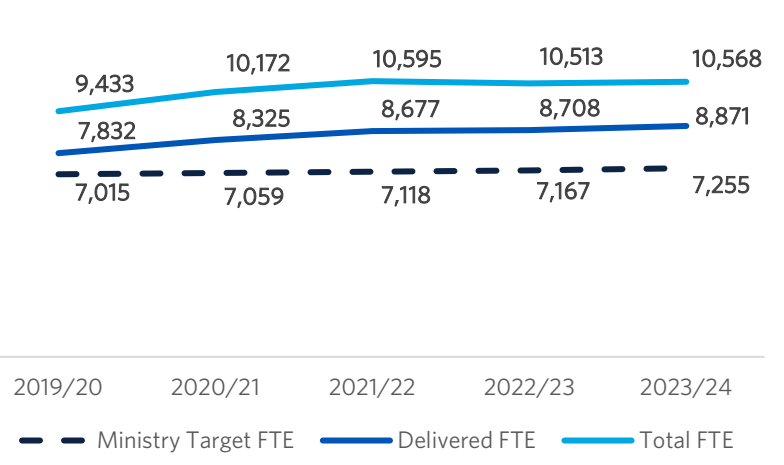

Headcount totals are valid as of November 1. Undergraduate students are full-time if enrolled in 24 or more credits. All doctoral students are considered full-time. Master's students are full-time if registered in a thesis, research project, or in 2 or more courses per term.

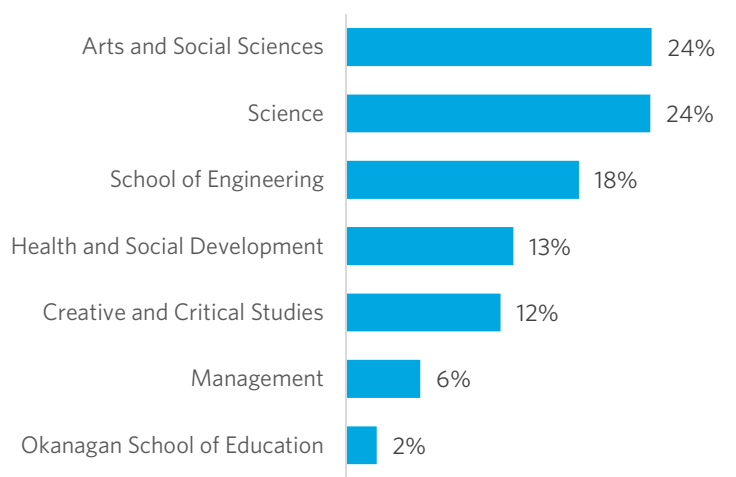
FTE ENROLMENT OVER TIME



Total FTE includes all students. Ministry Target FTE (these targets are the FTE funded by the Ministry which excludes international undergraduate students). FTE totals are valid as of March 1 (2023/24 November 1 actuals projected to March 1). Undergraduate FTE are normal program load. Graduate FTE are annualized. FTE includes Summer and Winter session activity.

WINTER SESSION UNDERGRADUATE COURSE ENROLMENTS BY FACULTY

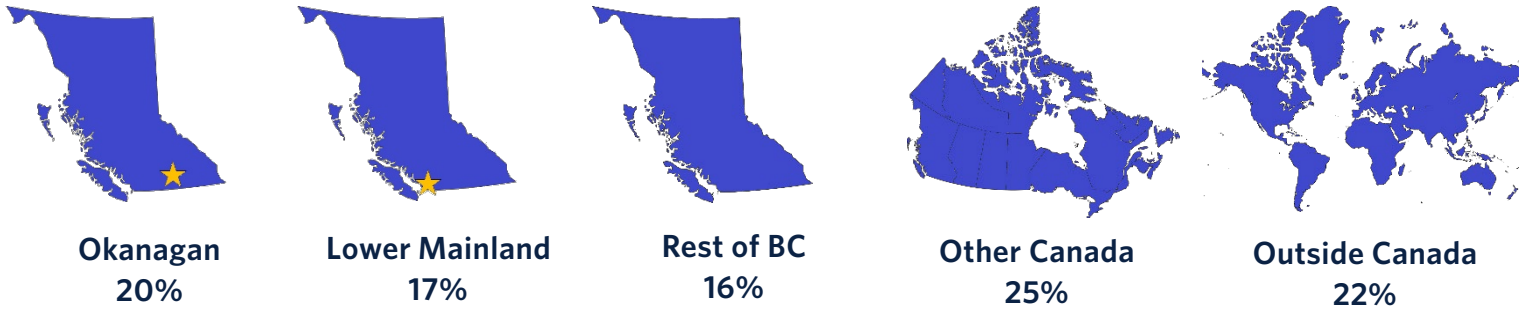

Location of Previous Institution Attended, New Undergraduate Direct-Entry Students (2022/23)

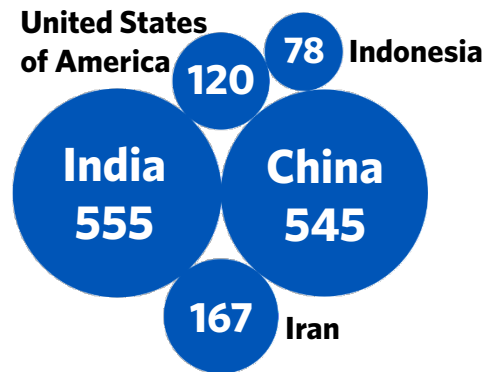

TOP 5 COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES OF INTERNATIONAL CITIZENSHIP



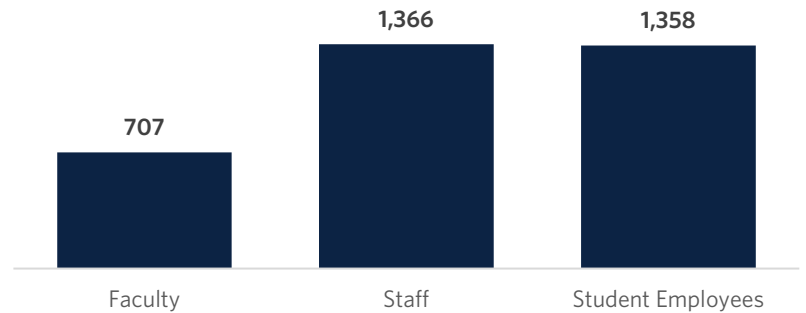
